## WHAT TO BRING - ALL POSITIONS

Heytesbury Pastoral Stations are located in North Australia, in regional locations. Here's a list of things to bring along to help you through the Season. All staff are provided a Heytesbury Pastoral work shirt and cap, with the option to order additional company apparel. - Single bed linen, pillow, doona, sheets & pillow case
- Towels & bath mat
- Toiletries
- Wide brim hat, sunscreen & sunglasses
- Drink bottle, 5L for those working with cattle / in yards
- Swag with additional linen, warm blanket & (optional) camp chair
- Tidy casual clothes to join team at campdrafts, rodeos & events
- Prescriptions / Medicines - enough for several months
- Torch or head torch (additional to mobile phone)
- A fun, 'can do' attitude



### STATION HAND

- Riding boots, closed-in boot or sneakers for cattle yard work.
- 5 to 7 pairs of riding jeans, long sleeve workshirts & jacket/jumper.
- Saddlebag or water bottle holder for saddle/bike.
- Long handle fencing pliers & fencing gloves & (optional) UHF pouch.

### STATION COOK

- Comfortable & safe footwear to stand for long hours in the kitchen.
- While there are knives in the kitchen, you're welcome to bring your own, that only you use.
- A neat & presentable daily uniform. We suggest jeans & long sleeve shirts.
